In clarification no. 2 in Addendum No. 10, regarding the method of submission of the Pre-Qualification Forms in another language, the Tender Committee clarified that the signatory of the relevant Participating Entity will sign the translated Pre-Qualification Forms and the signature shall be authenticated by a notary, ensuring that the notary's confirmation conforms to the text printed at the bottom of the Pre-Qualification Forms, including confirmation that the authorized signatory was warned of the consequences of making a false statement with regard to the declarations contained therein.

Subsequently, the Tender Committee was requested to allow for the notary's confirmation and statement of signature (which will be translated in English by a notary) to be made in accordance with the local laws and not conform to the text printed at the bottom of the Pre-Oualification Forms.

- A: The Tender Committee clarifies that the notary's authorization does not need to conform word for word to the text at the bottom of the Pre-Qualification Forms. However, in accordance with Section 56.1 of the Invitation, such confirmation must confirm that the signatory:
 - (i) was cautioned that he/she is required to state the truth, and that if he/she fails to do so he/she shall be liable to the punishments prescribed by law; and
 - (ii) is authorized to submit the required information on behalf of such Entity and to commit such Entity in relation to the document on which such signature appears.
